Around 68% of the students had said **"Very Good" & "Good"** and 26% of the students had said **"Excellent"** towards the student-teacher interaction, clearing doubts and process of assignment submission & examination through online teaching and learning. 71% of respondents had expressed **"Very Good" & "Good"** and 23 % said **"Excellent"** for discussion of performance in assignments. The Student feedback for 2020-21 (Post-graduate) was collected from 346 students of Voorhees College, Vellore. Among the total respondents 62.8% constitutes male and 37.2 % constitutes female. Around 68% of the total respondents agreed **"Very Good" &"Good"** and 25 % agreed for **"Excellent"** for the Syllabus covered in the class. More than 68% & 76% of the students had said **"Very Good" &"Good"** and around 24.2% & 26.5% had said **"Excellent"** for the understanding the subject and satisfaction of internal evaluation. Regarding to the study materials sent through Google/social media platform, nearly 60 % expressed **"Very Good" &"Good"** and 28% expressed **"Excellent"**. Around 66% of the students had said **"Very Good" & "Good"** and 25% of the students had said **"Excellent"** towards the student-teacher interaction, clearing doubts and process of assignment submission & examination through online teaching and learning. 71% of respondents had expressed **"Very Good" & "Good"**, 23 % said **"Excellent"** and 9.2% expressed **"Fair"** for discussion of performance in assignments. 
